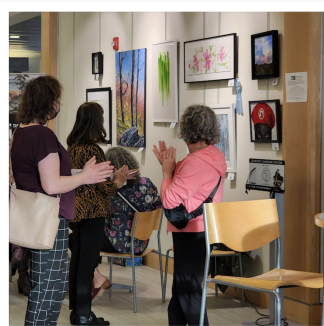

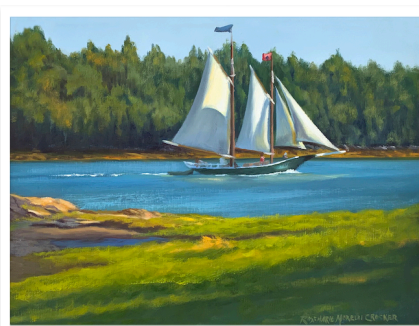
Spring Members' Exhibit

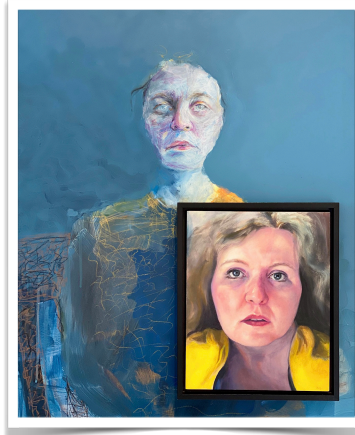
to the Westwood Library for hosting the exhibit through the end of May!

Artist of the Month Alex Cullen



“I like to create works that have a sense of time and place. Having people in my paintings helps do this - on occasion I’ve added people to a painting who weren’t in the original scene. I get enormous satisfaction from the process of painting; the studies done in advance to work on key elements, and the

progression of refinement until I can stand back and say ‘that looks right.’”

Alex Cullen has a degree in Fine Art from the University of New Hampshire. In his earlier years - before marriage, kids and career, he lived in New York and took advantage of the art scene there to create pastels and watercolors. Upon retirement, he returned to his art. He uses pastel and watercolor for quick works, and acrylic for more developed ones.

Museum Trip to the MFA

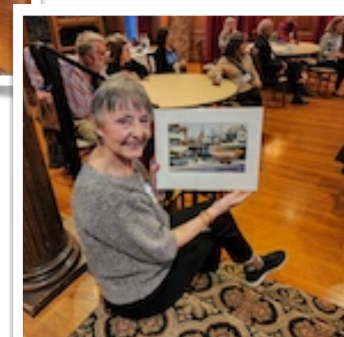

- ❖ Entry Fee: \$15 (add \$3 handling if credit card or PayPal, total \$18)
 - Contributions in addition to entry fees are welcome and will augment our community fund.
- ❖ Registration form (below) and JPEG Submission due July 1; Drop-Off will be on or about August 26
- ❖ Size (including frame): minimum accepted 30" x 40" / maximum accepted 7' x 7'
- ❖ Dedham Art Association Exhibit Rules apply (please see our website and click on "Exhibits").
 - As a special exception for this permanent exhibit call for entries, you may enter an artwork that you previously submitted for any of the prior PNC Bank Large Works exhibits.
- ❖ If your artwork is selected, it will not be returned. It will be purchased by PNC Bank and remain on permanent exhibit. PNC Bank will award \$500 to each selected artist to purchase their artwork. Dedham Art Association is waiving the usual 20% commission on juried artwork sales this time as a special exception.
- ❖ Selected artists will be notified by July 18 and asked for an artist photo and artist bio for printed flyers and wall placards. You will be required to sign a release by July 22 in order to complete the transaction.
