member of the Rhode Island Watercolor Society, a juried artist in the Cape Cod Art Association and is a member of the Attleboro Arts Museum, the Monotype Guild of New England and Wickford Art Association. Watercolor has been Mary's principle medium during her painting career with subjects taken most often from the natural surroundings of her New England home. Most recently, Mary's art has expanded beyond representational toward a more explorative and experimental approach and includes work in alcohol ink painting and monotype printmaking as well. Mary's work has been accepted into many juried exhibitions, local, regional and national, and has received awards.

## Artist of the Month Richard Scott



I am now a retired surgeon. I am a self-taught artist and began painting and drawing shortly after I eloped with my wife in 1963 during our Junior year in college. I started out doing abstract paintings and sold them to help make ends meet. I soon decided to try to emulate the impressionists so I could learn their technique. I

learned their technique. I painted in oil and used only a pallet knife so that I didn't have to clean any brushes. Some of my "derivative art" looked pretty good, and we began to put some on the walls of our home. My wife once overheard a dinner guest whisper to her partner "They have a Monet!"

During my busy surgical career and our child raising years, my painting opportunities slowed down, but my interest started up again after retirement. I tried to branch out by using brushes with acrylics and trying different motifs.

### About Tom Hughes, Watercolor Workshop Instructor

Tom Hughes was born in Massachusetts in 1965. He was a staff artist at the Christian Science Monitor newspaper in Boston in the 1980's, leaving to practice fine art, at which he's been occupied for more than 30 years.

Once referred to as "a genius" by late, renowned artist and author Charles Movalli, Hughes has had solo exhibitions in galleries in the New England States, North Carolina, Lake Tahoe, San Francisco, and France. He is proficient in several painting media including oil, acrylic, and watercolor, with subject matter comprised of figure painting, portrait,

landscape and the odd still life or genre picture. Hughes's work has been featured in *American Artist Watercolor* magazine, *Fine Art Connoisseur*, for which he painted the magazine's publisher B. Eric Rhoads's portrait, and *Southwest Art* magazine. An example of Hughes's watercolor painting is featured in *Watercolor Painting* by Tom Hoffmann (Watson Guptill, 2012). In 2019, Tom Hughes won the \$15,000 Grand Prize for painting at the Plein Air Convention and Expo, held in San Francisco.

In 2018, Tom Hughes became a signature member of the Plein Air Painters of America.

Tom lives in New Hampshire's seacoast region.

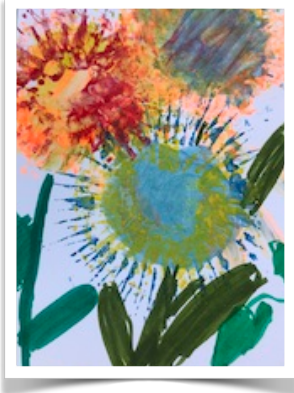

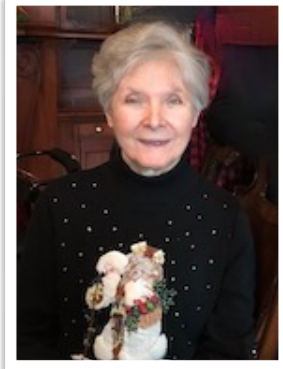

## Ann Coco Art Scholarship

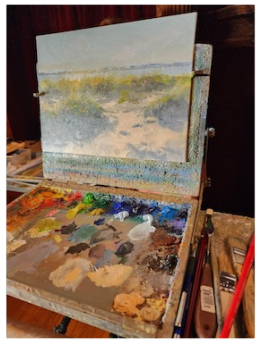

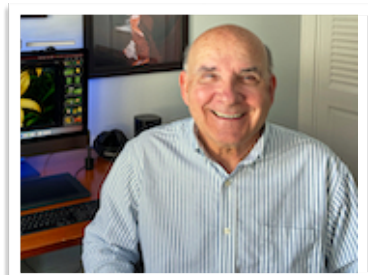

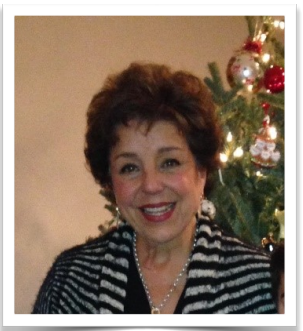
