Each participating artist will have at least one artwork critiqued.

Irena Roman is a transparent watercolorist with 30+ years of experience. Prior to devoting herself exclusively to fine art, Irena was a freelance illustrator, creating artwork for clients such as the New Yorker magazine,

The Atlantic, Harper Collins Children's Books, Little Brown Publishing, the US Postal Service, and many others. She's a signature member and Dolphin Fellow of the American Watercolor Society and has received a Silver Medal of Honor (2022), a High Winds Medal (2011), and the Ralph Smith Memorial Award (2012) in their prestigious International Juried Exhibition. Irena holds a BFA from Massachusetts College of Art and Design, Boston (where she is a professor) and an MFA from Syracuse University.




John Roman is an illustrator specializing in the visual translation of complex information with illustrated maps, architectural and technical drawings. His clients include Time, The National Park Service, The

# Michael Rose Dedham Art Association's 2024 Spring Members' Exhibit Juror

Michael Rose is an art historian, gallerist, and writer based in Providence, Rhode Island. Since 2014, Michael has served as gallery manager at the historic Providence Art Club where he oversees a complex exhibition schedule spread across three unique gallery

spaces. Under Michael's leadership, the galleries of the Art Club have received coveted Best of RI Awards for Best Art Gallery in Providence every year since 2019 and have also been recognized as one of the top three art galleries in the state by the Providence Journal.

In addition to his work at the Art Club, Michael is also an independent curator, sought after educator, and frequent juror, having collaborated on projects with a range of organizations throughout New England. He has served on juries for the Rhode Island State Council on the Arts, Bristol Art Museum, Duxbury Art Association, Plymouth Center for the Arts, South Coast Artists, Connecticut Academy of Fine Arts, Lyme Art Association, and many others. A prolific writer and critic, Michael authors the weekly "Inside Art" column for local news site GoLocalProv.com, covering artists and art exhibitions throughout Rhode Island.

Michael earned his BA in Art History at Providence College and went on to obtain his Certificate in Appraisal Studies in Fine and Decorative Arts at New York University. An alumnus of AS220's nationally acclaimed Practice//Practice Residency for arts administrators, Michael has completed additional coursework with the New England Museum Association, the American Association of Appraisers, Rhode Island School of Design, and Harvard Graduate School of Design.

# **Artist of the Month**Gianna Bird



"Hi! I am an artist, maker, problem solver, and teacher, with a strong interest in how things work. After a lifetime of crafting, 25 years of silversmithing, and a deep love of nature, watercolor has become my lasting obsession. In 2011 I began taking classes

from local artists, Imadiel Ariel and Nan Rumpf, and my life was changed. I love watercolor for so many reasons, but I think it's mainly for its challenge. Every time I pick up the brush I have to be ready and present for whatever adventure, and surprise, is coming.

A few years ago I began working at the Dedham Library, offering programs for adults, and although I didn't feel like I knew quite enough to teach watercolor, I knew that if you really want to learn something, teach it! So, I taught beginner watercolor classes during the pandemic and these classes are still going. I have learned so much! Joining the Dedham Art Association has also helped me broaden my learning, through the wonderful demos and talks that have been offered, and the plein air events I've been fortunate to attend.

I recently realized that my creative work not only involves making my own art, but also creating opportunities for others to explore their world and themselves in new ways. So, I've taken this realization and built an online space for classes and workshops. In these classes, I try to encourage adult students to experiment and explore, to feel confidence in their own artistic abilities and discover novel ways of self-expression. This has fostered a sense of community and connection, going beyond technical skills, that makes me really happy.

Through my online platform, which is donation-based, my goal is to create a virtual space where individuals from all walks of life, and from around the world can come together to learn, grow, find inspiration, and be creative.



  entries that meet the exhibit guidelines will be in the exhibit. Cash prizes will be awarded to First,
  Second and Third place. Honorable Mention Awards and a People's Choice Award will also be recognized.
- Please review Dedham Art Association Exhibit Guidelines on the landing page of ArtCall or our website, <u>Dedham Art Association Exhibit Guidelines</u>. No work larger than 30" x 40". DAA commission is 20% of art sales. NFS (not for sale) is allowed for this exhibit.
- For sales, artists are responsible for reporting and paying any governmental fees, including but not limited to sales tax.

We use ArtCall for online registration where you can sign in and create your account or access an existing account. Your artwork JPEG is loaded in, Title, Dimensions, Image info (Note: when entering dimensions fill in the depth as well as height and width.) Once you have successfully registered, you will receive an email confirmation for your entry. For extra guidance, a video is available on the entry page explaining the process.

You will need an email address. New to ArtCall: click the Register & Apply button at top of screen and sign up with an email and a password. If you have used ArtCall and have an account, you can use the same log in and password. The \$18 registration fee is payable by credit card.
