Cindy Baron to Demonstrate



Please join us for the initial meeting of the year on Tuesday, September 12th at the Endicott Estate ballroom (656 East Street in Dedham)

beginning at 6:45 PM and on Zoom. Cindy Baron will give an oil painting demonstration. Zoom links will be emailed a few days before our meeting.

Cindy is nationally recognized in both watercolors and oils, painting the grand landscapes of the western mountains and coastal shorelines.

Raised in South Bend, Indiana she has had the experience of living and painting all over the country. Her art career started early when her 1st grade teacher noticed her drawings, which lead to weekends assisting teachers through high school at the Art Center in town. A full-time artist, she conducts workshops across the country and internationally and has taught at the Rhode Island School of Design in their Continuing Education department.

Her passion in the arts began with pastels, which then led to watercolors and in 2000 was awarded signaturestatus of The American Watercolor Society. In 2019, she became a master signature member of Oil Painters of America, and is among a select group of artist that has received acknowledgment from her peers in both mediums. A plein air painter enthusiast and her extensive travels have given Cindy an

abundance of information and knowledge, which she shares with her students. She has become a highly sought after instructor, teaching her skills around the country and Continuing Education classes to teachers. She has had the privilege of judging many award shows and has been featured in numerous publications.

Her paintings reflect the beauty that is found in nature, if you take the time to study the colors around you. She can capture beauty in a blustering storm or the tranquil air of everyday places. Her portraitures relay a story of human life as though they were family or friend. The versatility of mediums, subjects, keeps her energized, excited and creative. She finds that each medium has influenced the other, which gives her paintings a wall of their own.

Call for Entries Fall Members' Exhibit at the Walpole Library

All current Dedham Art Association members are invited to exhibit in our Fall show. We hope you can all participate. The registration fee is \$18, and each member artist may enter one artwork created within the past 5 years. (Entries should not have been exhibited in previous DAA judged exhibits within three years.) All entries will be in the exhibit. No work larger than 30" x 40". Cash awards will be presented. DAA commission is 20% of art sales. NFS (not for sale) is allowed. Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Honorable Mentions will be recognized, and a People's Choice award will be presented at the end of show.

Using ArtCall

We will be using the program <u>ArtCall</u> again to make the registration and online gallery process easier. Please review updated Exhibit guidelines on the landing page of <u>ArtCall</u> or our website. From our homepage Click "Exhibits". In upper right of the page click button "Exhibits Guidelines" and again from there in upper right click button "Download guidelines PDF".

As a reminder, the submitting artist is responsible for reporting and paying any governmental fees, including but not limited to sales tax.

Register on ArtCall

If you already have used this program for another ArtCall, use the login button. If this is your first time, click the register button at top of screen and sign up with an email and a password. You will sign in and create your own ArtCall login. From there you will upload your JPEG, enter your Title, Dimensions, Image info (please note when entering dimensions you will need to fill in the depth as well. In most cases, just add the number 1). Once your work is entered and uploaded, a gallery will be created of all the entries that will be posted on our website when the show opens. Please make every effort to use this program moving forward. If this is a challenge for you, ask a friend or family member for help. The \$18 registration fee is payable by credit card. A movie is available on the entry page explaining this process.

Dedham Senior Center Solo Exhibit Mark J. Richards, Landscape Painter

Mark's exhibit at the Dedham Senior Center runs through September. The Dedham Senior Center is our ongoing rotating exhibit space.

Landscape painting is first and foremost the Artist's expression of self within the context of the natural environment.



Mark J. Richards landscapes are presented as portrait paintings that impact viewers to critically think about their world view, our environment, and their place within it: landscape paintings as being, doing, and finding out. He refers to these paintings as Color Seasons.


Each painting expresses nonverbal meanings that ask for immediate reflection. Mark's paintings challenge viewers to be emotionally affected by what is shown and by what is beyond the edges of each painting.

These natural motifs from nature lend themselves to active brush work, expressing decisiveness and authority of touch. Long, freely applied sweeps of complimentary colors surge forward and back to excite and challenge the depiction and understanding of forms from a psychological space within nature.

An Artist Reception will be held on September 20th, from 5-6:30pm and the Ames Building (Town Hall and Senior Center) at 450 Washington St, Dedham, and also on view M – F between 8:30 am – 4:30 pm. If you are interested in applying to exhibit at the Dedham Senior Center, please contact


